## REAL ID does not go into effect until October 1, 2020.

Your current Illinois driver's license or ID card (DL/ID) will be accepted at airports, military bases and secure federal facilities until Oct. 1, 2020. We are providing you with the choice either to obtain a REAL ID card or to keep a standard card. Take time to know your options.

- You have a valid U.S. passport or passport card; or
- You do **not** use airplanes as a mode of domestic transportation; or
- You do **not** visit military bases; or
- You do **not** visit secure federal facilities.

## You **NEED** a REAL ID if:

- You do **not** have a valid U.S. passport or passport card; AND
- You use airplanes as a mode of domestic transportation; or
- You visit military bases; or
- You visit secure federal facilities.

Application Process for Standard Driver's License or ID

If your DL/ID is currently valid and not expiring soon, you do not need to do anything.

Step 1: If your DL/ID is expiring soon, visit a <u>Secretary of State Driver Services facility</u> and take your photo and any required exams.

Step 2: Receive a temporary, secure paper DL/ID at the facility.

Step 3: After review and verification of documents have been conducted, your new permanent standard DL/ID will be mailed to you within 15 business days.



Application Process for **REAL ID** Driver's License or ID

Step 1: Visit a <u>Secretary of State Driver</u> <u>Services facility</u> and take your photo and any required exams.

Step 2: All applicants must provide proof of identity. (Examples are: a certified U.S. birth certificate, a U.S. passport, an employment authorization document, a permanent resident card or a foreign passport with an approved I-94 form.) \*Name change documents, such as certified copies of a marriage certificate, divorce decree, etc., will be required if the applicant presents a certified birth certificate with a name different from his/her current name. Please note: Multiple name change documents will be required if your name has changed multiple times.

Step 3: All applicants must provide proof of full Social Security number (SSN). (Examples are: an SSN card, a W-2 or a pay stub with full SSN.)

Step 4: All applicants must provide two current residency documents with the applicant's name. (Examples are: a utility bill, rental agreement, deed/title or a bank statement.)

Step 5: All applicants must provide proof of signature. (Examples are: a credit/debit card,

canceled check or current Illinois DL/ID.)

Step 6: Receive a temporary, secure paper DL/ID at the facility. \**Please note that the TSA and federal agents will not accept the paper document.* 

Step 7: After review and verification of documents have been conducted, your new permanent REAL ID card will be mailed to you within 15 business days.

- Fees for a standard DL/ID and REAL ID DL/ID are the same.
- If you recently renewed, or if your license does not expire for more than one year, you
  may apply for a REAL ID and pay a \$5 corrected fee. Your REAL ID will retain the same
  expiration date as your original license.
- For domestic travel, a U.S. passport or a REAL ID card is acceptable. For international travel, a U.S. passport is necessary.
